The goal of NEXT is to enhance our presence in the community and establish a foundation for growth that will allow future generations to hear the life-changing message of the Gospel.

The Focus:

FIRST IMPRESSION



Modernize + improve the exterior presence of the building.

WHY?

Our 30-year-old building does not reflect the vibrant church that occupies the space. A new and updated facade will create a better first impression, be more welcoming visually, and create better curb appeal for our community.

QUICK FACTS:

- Replace outdated "portico"
- Add additional glass doors
- Replace outdated dome-shaped windows
- Updated elevation and landscaping
- Cost: 200K*

FOYER CONNECTION



Expand foyer with new cafe + fenced-in play area.

WHY?

Our current foyer forces people to funnel out of church too quickly, not allowing time for valuable connections and conversations.

QUICK FACTS:

- Remove wall between current foyer and Fuse room
- New flooring, lighting, and ceiling
- New cafe & doors
- Fenced-in play area with seating
- Cost: 100K*

FAMILY CENTER



Build a new Family Center to expand our current kid's ministry on the south side of current building.

WHY?

The space is needed to provide a better environment for our Family Ministry and for Freedom Christian Academy. This will also place Children's Ministry on one side of the building providing a better and secure area.

QUICK FACTS:

- 2500 sq ft
- Break ground Summer 2022
- Cost: 500K*

How will we pay for it?

Our goal is to raise as much money as possible over the next 25 months, and secure a loan from Christian Financial Resources for the remaining funds needed to fulfill the vision of NEXT. We will limit the size of any required loan to ensure we always practice fiscal responsibility and model wise stewardship.
